General Information

## Understanding Your Bill

Act 129 Compliance Rider - Charge to recover costs associated with Energy Efficiency and Conservation programs for customers as approved by the Public Utility Commission.
Storm Damage Expense Rider - A charge to recover eligible storm damage expenses that are not otherwise recovered through base rates.
Competitive Enhancement Rider - Charge to recover costs related to implementing the Public Utility Commission's retail market enhancement programs, including certain consumer education costs.
Customer Qharge - Monthly basic distribution charge to cover costs for billing, meter reading, equipment, maintenance and advanced metering when in use.
Distribution Charge - Charge for the use of local wires, transformers, substations and other equipment used to deliver electricity to end-use consumers from the high voltage transmission lines.

System Improvement Charge - A charge used to recover costs for repairing, improving, or replaing distribution fadilities in order to provide safe, reliable, and efficient service.
Generation Charge - Charge for the production of electricity. Supply Charge - Charge for the electricity you receive either from PPL Electric Utilities or the Supplier you have chosen. The amount you pay per kilowatt-hour (kVh) may be a fixed or variable price.
$\mathbf{k W h}$ (Kilowatt-hour) - The basic unit of electric energy for whic most customers are charged. The amount of electricity used by ten 100 -watt lights left on for 1 hour. Consumers are usually charged for electricity in cents per kilowatt-hour.
Smart Meter Rider - Charge to recover costs associated with the Smart Meter Plan for customers as approved by the PUC.

## Understanding Your Bill cont'd (if applicable)

State Tax Adjustment Surcharge - Charge or credit on electric rates to reflect changes in various state taxes induded in your bill. The surcharge may vary by bill component.
Transmission Charge - Charge for moving high voltage
electricity froma generation fadility to the distribution lines of an electric distribution company.
Type(s) of Meter Readings:
Adtual - Reading by distribution company.
Estimated - Usage based on the weather and your past energy use.
